

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

OSE operated one train each way between Díkea and Svilengrad until August 2009. No service was reported for the 2010-11 timetable or for subsequent years. In September 2017 it was reported that Bulgaria and Greece had signed a Memorandum of Understanding on the upgrade of that railway to connect three Greek ports (Thessaloniki, Kavala, Alexandroupolis) with three Bulgarian ports (Burgas and Varna on the Black Sea and Ruse on the Danube) but obvioulsy mainly for purposes of freight traffic.
